

Abstracts and Works in Progress Submission Guidelines

We want to encourage the development of new research through the presentation of Abstracts and Works in Progress. These events are a great venue in which to receive initial feedback on a concept as well as to solicit potential co-authors.

The following information should be prepared and submitted to the EDSIG Papers Management System (<http://csbapp.csb.uncw.edu/edsig>)

1. Title
2. Authors: Name, affiliation, & email address
3. General Track/Subject Area (see website for tracks)
4. Abstract: Maximum of **500** words + optional short bibliography (Bibliography does not count toward word count and may be formatted in any standard format.)

Abstracts may include 1 figure or diagram in addition to the text.

The submitted material will be considered for presentation at the ISECON/CONISAR 2013 Conference. Neither abstracts nor works in progress will be considered for journal publications, but abstracts will appear in the conference proceedings.

Ten minutes of presentation time and 5 minutes of discussion will be allocated for each abstract/WIP.
